With summer almost here I have received a number of enquiries about the replacement of the pool changing sheds.

The cost of replacing the sheds is very high due to the nature of the soil that they sit on. This has meant that the cost of our original plan - a concrete tilt slab building – was too high to make the project viable.

After much thought and discussion we have now agreed to a new design that requires less work on the foundations and accordingly less cost. At the same time the design is a little simpler though it also promises to be interesting and not your normal pool changing shed facility!

Much of the work can be done off site and we now anticipate that subject to things like having good weather over summer we should be back swimming in March next year.

I appreciate that this project has taken a little longer than we expected but I am certain the wait will ultimately be worthwhile.
