Hello,

I have been contacted by Northland District Health Board regarding the two outbreaks of Measles in Northland. They advise that Northland is experiencing its lowest immunisation rates for many years, which could lead to a rapid spread of this disease.

We would like to be proactive as a school, and would appreciate your co-operation in providing immunisation records for your children. If you do not have these records, your doctor will have the information required.

Measles is an extremely serious disease and is easily transmitted from child to child. Although as a school we cannot prevent a child from attending school if they are well, it would be a matter for you to strongly consider if your child is un-immunised.

Our School Board of Trustees elections are approaching, and nomination forms will be sent home to eligible people via NZ post this week. We are in the pleasurable situation of having the current BOT willing to re-stand with 1 other nominated. If there are any other nominations we will need to run an election.
