Prepared at home

Pets: A registration form must be collected from the office and a story written about the pet. The judges consider the story when judging. Registration forms and Pet Stories must be handed to Mrs Hancock by Wednesday 23rd October

Animal categories are:

- Calf/lamb/kid
- Dogs
- Cats
- Small pets (guinea pigs, rabbits, birds etc)
- Pet rock/virtual pet

Baking: Displayed and judged in the Hall

- Pizza (1 slice)
- Cupcakes (3 pieces)

Habitat: Displayed and judged in the Hall

- Can be any theme but must be where someone or something lives

Prepared in Class

Floral Display: Displayed and judged in classrooms

- Sand Saucer (donations of flowers gladly accepted for this)
- Aqua Jar (please bring an air tight jar)
- Vegetable/Fruit model (please bring vegetable/fruit) Toothpicks, raisins and some bits supplied.

Raffles: The PTA will hold its annual Monster Grocery Raffle and we welcome any donations towards this. Non-perishable items can be brought into school any time and perishable items such as meat and fresh vegetables etc can be brought on the morning of Pet Day. Tickets will be sold at \$2 each or 3 for \$5.

Cake Stall: The PTA will also be holding the ever popular cake stall. A cake box will be sent home at the start of Week 2 and any donations of cakes, biscuits etc are much appreciated. The money the PTA makes on this day goes to cover the bouncy castle hire, pet ribbons and other costs associated with Pet day.
