





Kia ora from Miss Lawson and Mrs Smith!


Write: Pretend you were a soldier in the war and you are writing back to your family and loved ones in New Zealand. What would you tell them? Think about what would be going on around you, how you would feel and what might you say/not say to your loved ones.

Start your letter with 'Dear loved one,' and end it by signing your name.



Spell: See if you can come up with 10 words of your own that relate to ANZAC day. Your goal is to be able to spell each of them correctly by the end of the week. Use the article you have read to help you.

Here are a few if you are stuck... poppies, red, black, soldiers, war, New Zealand, Australia, fight, anniversary, commemorate, defeat, Gallipoli, ceremony, tradition, ANZAC, marching, dawn...



Investigate these maths problems - complete at least 2 of the 4 problems and remember to show your working.

$$\begin{aligned} \text{Apple} + \text{Apple} + \text{Apple} &= 30 \\ \text{Apple} + \text{Banana} + \text{Banana} &= 18 \\ \text{Banana} - \text{Cherry} &= 2 \\ \text{Cherry} + \text{Apple} + \text{Banana} &= ?? \end{aligned}$$

$$\begin{aligned} \text{Apple} + \text{Apple} + \text{Apple} &= 18 \\ \text{Apple} + \text{Banana} + \text{Banana} &= 14 \\ \text{Banana} - \text{Cherry} &= 2 \\ \text{Cherry} + \text{Apple} + \text{Banana} &= ? \end{aligned}$$

$$\begin{aligned} \text{Kiwi} + \text{Apple} + \text{Kiwi} &= 22 \\ \text{Pear} + \text{Pear} + \text{Kiwi} &= 28 \\ \text{Apple} + \text{Apple} + \text{Pear} &= 38 \\ \text{Apple} \times \text{Kiwi} \times \text{Pear} &= ? \end{aligned}$$

$$\begin{aligned} \text{Blue Cup} + \text{Blue Cup} + \text{Blue Cup} &= 15 \\ \text{Orange Cup} - \text{Orange Cup} + \text{Blue Cup} &= 10 \\ \text{Red Cup} + \text{Red Cup} - \text{Orange Cup} &= 06 \\ \text{Blue Cup} + \text{Red Cup} \times \text{Orange Cup} &= ? \end{aligned}$$
