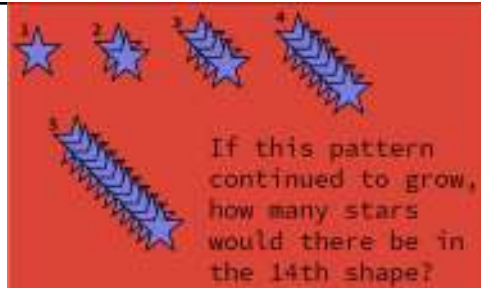
Click the link below, read the clues and zoom around the world to try and discover where in the world is Carmen Sandiago. Afterwards make a list of all the countries you visited.

Tip: At the start it is okay to use a 2 letter or 3 letter blend, this will help you create larger words later on.



## How do plants work?

Investigate how a weed grows. Choose a weed from you garden and use your scientist eye to discover all the parts that make up this plant. Carefully pull the weed to pieces, slice down the stem, look inside the leaves and investigate the roots. Draw a sketch of all the parts you can see. Make a hypothesis (guess) about what these parts do.
