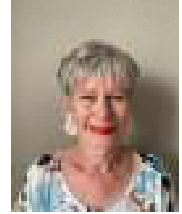




Kaeo School at Home

I have used Mita's name but you could be Mita with these instructions:

Mita has been blindfolded. His sister and brother have given him some instructions to follow. They say that he has to walk three steps forward and then make a quarter turn clockwise. They get him to do that three more times in a row. What shape has Mita walked?

Could you get Mita to 'walk out' a square shape using clockwise and anticlockwise turns? What other shapes can you instruct Mita to 'walk out'? Get someone in your bubble to blindfold you and give you instructions to walk around your home and see what shapes you make. Have fun and be careful when you are stepping out your instructions.



For writing this week we have **"Where is Spot?"** (*I can't find Spot anywhere, Is he in your bubble?*) Tell us what Spot has been up to if he has been in your bubble or tell us what you would be doing with Spot if he was in your bubble. You could start your story with :

Spot is in my bubble and we have been.....

Spot is not in my bubble but if he was we would.....
