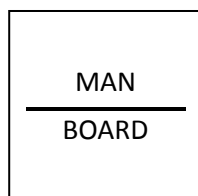
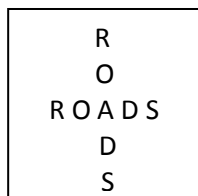
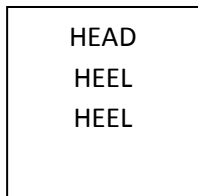
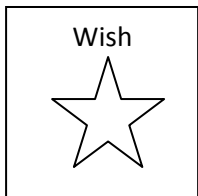
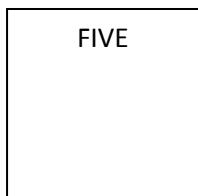
I have been missing seeing all of your smiling faces and I know that you might be getting a bit bored at home so here a few things to keep you busy for a little while.

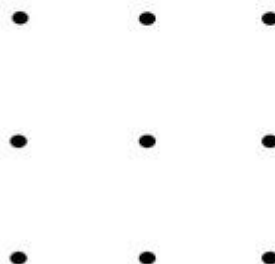
