Hello again Room 5! Enjoy todays activities!

This is a story is about Valentine’s Day **but** what a good opportunity to use this idea while you are at home to tell someone or everyone how much you love them, like them, appreciate them, or simply just to tell them, you think they are cool! Here are some questions first to see how well you read the story:

## Read



Today is Valentine’s Day! Johnny is so excited, because he gets to deliver Valentines to all his friends. First, he put the Valentine cards in his bag. He jumps on his scooter and goes to Jill’s house. After that, Johnny delivers cards to Ben, Jane, Jessie and Carla. He has one more Valentine to hand out. He heads home to deliver the special Valentine.

What is a good title for the story?

Why is Johnny excited?

How many Valentines did Johnny deliver?

Make an inference. Who did you think Johnny will deliver his last card to? How do you know?



Today we want you to write a story about all of the things you have been able to do at home.

Here are some suggestions—playing dress-ups, helping with chores around the house, helping with baking a cake or cookies, your scavenger hunts, art , washing the dog, cuddling your cat, walking your *guinea pig* or your pig.

Remember to read it back to yourself so that it makes sense. Look to see if you remembered your capital letters, full stops, speech marks or exclamation marks.



For each of your spelling words think of putting that word into a sentence. You don’t have to write these down, just give the person who is helping you your wonderful ideas.



Where oh where can Whaea Gee be? CLUE - Starts with **s** and ends in **!**

1. I see lots of classrooms. The tamariki like to play near here. We love it when Mr Barker lets us throw the leaves around. Where am I? **{Draw it}**
2. I am near a big concrete rectangle and its lots of fun when I am full of water. Where am I? **{Draw it}**
3. This can be a quiet room. In the corner, on the desk is a scanner. Where am I? **{Draw it}**
4. We say hello to Sarah. We knock on the door. This room makes us smile. Where am I? **{Draw it}**
