Share another book with someone in your bubble, maybe one of your Duffy books or one online, and talk about the book. Try to use these key words when talking about the story.

Who What Where When Why How

Listen to the story **Some Dogs Do** by Jez Alborough <https://vimeo.com/54377075> In this story Sid the dog can fly (but only when he is happy) talk about where you would like to go if you could fly. Who would you like to fly with? Where would you like to go. What would you like to see?



Keep practising reading, writing and ordering numbers. Play **Caching Fish** in you Home School pack.

This week we are going to look at some new at **Fractions** called **quarters**. If you cut something into 4 equal parts each part is called a **quarter** or **1/4**. **Quarters** mean that there are **4 parts**. The 4 parts are **the same size**. The 4 parts fit together to make a whole. With your helper practise making quarters.

Cut your sandwich, a cake or pizza into quarters. Fold a tea towel into quarters. Find some shapes, a circle a square or rectangle draw around them, cut them out. see if you can fold them into quarters.

Try folding shapes or objects in half first and then half again to make quarters.



This week our letter of the week is the letter **Dd**. Take time to look around your bubble and see what you can discover that starts with this letter. Collect the things that you find. Draw pictures of these things and label them making sure you write the letter **Dd** correctly. You might like to try to write a sentence, or more, about what you discover. You could start your sentence with **Dd is for**like we used to for our cut up sentence in Term 1.



Make time to practise your **alphabet**, you need to know the letter names and the sounds the letters make. Sing **the alphabet song** <https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=hq3yfQnllfQ>

The Hungry Spelling caterpillar. Once there was a caterpillar who just loved to eat words, not just any words but only those words with 3 letters. Can you draw a caterpillar with a head and circles for the body. On each of the circles write a 3 letter word. Add some feet and colour your caterpillar. You can use some of the words on the Essential List 1 e.g. **the, and, was** but you will also have to find some others e.g. **mum, dad** etc.



As I was preparing your activity sheet I was sitting looking out of the window watching the autumn leaves fall off the trees. The weather has changed since we have been in Lockdown, we are now in the last month of Autumn! Time to do some Autumn Art. I want you to make a Leaf Family! You need to gather some Autumn leaves of different shapes if you can. Get enough leaves to represent everyone in your bubble. Glue them onto a piece of paper.

Decide which leaf will be which person. Draw on arms and legs and give your leaf people some eyes.

You can even add a pet to your leaf family if you would like to!
