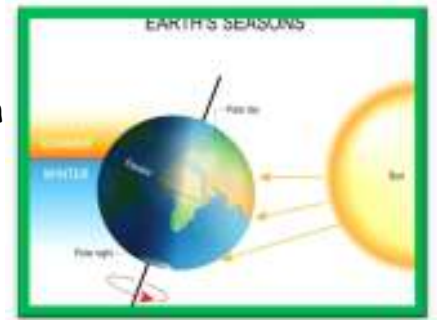
Seasons

We started off our term by looking at the seasons. We first went outside to see if we could see things in our environment that would give us clues to what season it was. What a wonderful opportunity we had seeing all the lovely trees and their colourful leaves dropping—It is Autumn!



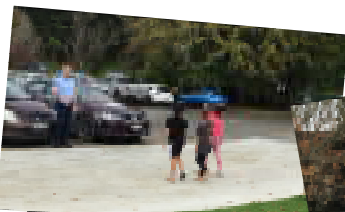
From here we already knew that there were four seasons, but how many months does each season have? We then had to do a bit of Maths. We knew there were 12 months in the year so had to find out how many groups of 4 there are in 12—there are 3! So each season has 3 months.

We worked out the months for each season and then created a flow chart. A lot of us learnt that we don't jump from Summer to Winter but instead have seasons in-between—Spring and Autumn. Our next question was WHY DO WE HAVE SEASONS? We then learnt that planet Earth is tilted on it's axis. As it moves around the sun different parts of the Earth are tilted towards the sun (warmer seasons) while other areas tilt away from the sun (cooler seasons).
