Hello,

In last week's newsletter I promised to provide some details of the feedback that everyone provided at parent interviews. Here are the main points:

98% of respondents think that their child is ok (5%), happy (18%), or very happy (75%) at school.

100% of respondents think that their child is building a positive relationship with their teacher yes (17%), very positive(26%), Fantastic (57%).

100% of respondents think that their child's learning is progressing well. Ok (11%), Very well (50%), Excellently (39%).

What people like best about Kaeo School includes:

The Community feel, the teachers, the tone, the helpful and supportive nature, caring and kindness, the focus on learning, the physical environment, its positiveness, that it is child focussed, that it is welcoming and approachable, its high standards, and its focus on the relationships between children and teachers.

Some ideas for improvement include:

A wee bit more emphasis on Te Reo Maori, letting the community know if a specific illness is in the school community, more sport, and more teacher aides.

Overall, this is very positive feedback – thank you for that but as always we will keep working to ensure the positive work continues and where we can that we work to improve our lovely school even more.
