

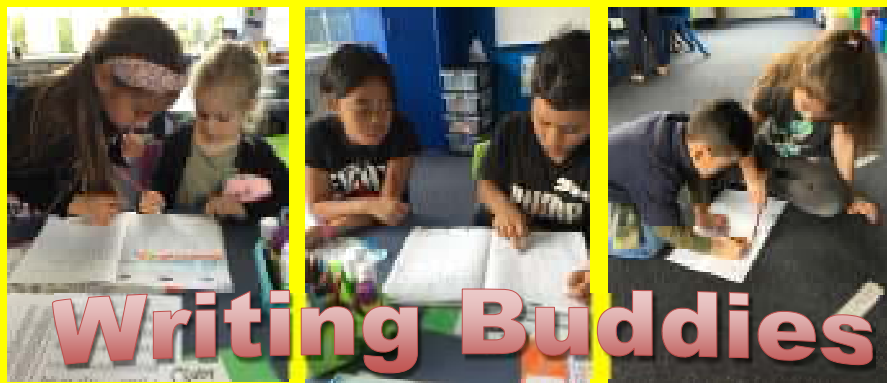
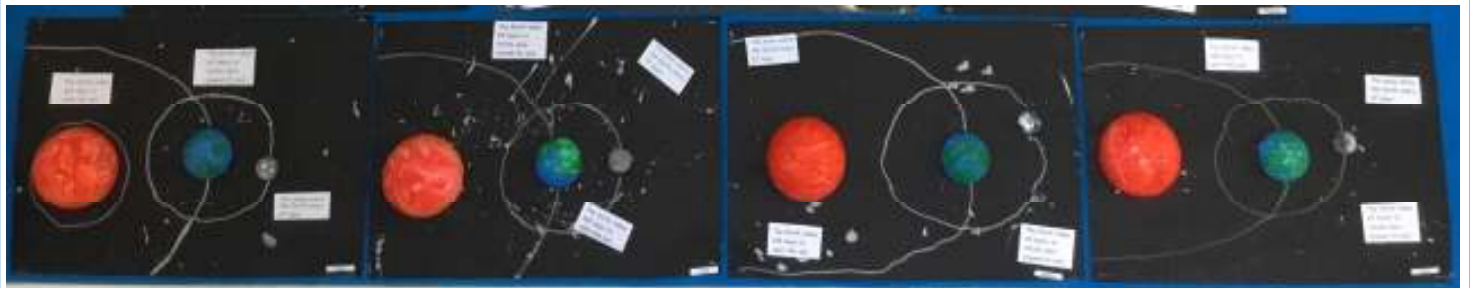
Room 5's Newsletter, Term 3, Week 1

Earth, Moon and Sun



In Room 5 we have been studying the Earth, our moon and the Sun. We asked lots of questions. Here are a few facts we found out:

- The Earth takes 365 days to orbit the sun (a year).
- The moon orbits the earth and takes about 28 days. During this time it has different phases (crescent, full, new, gibbous, quarter).
- The moon surface is covered in craters.
- The Earth orbits around its own axis and takes 24 hours (a day).
- The sun is made up of gases (mainly hydrogen and helium).
- The sun is a star and provides us with light and heat on Earth.



We've been working with our Writing Buddy to help edit our stories. We use our goal sheet to help guide our marking and once we have finished we have an opportunity to share what we have written with the class.
