Following on with the toilet paper themed questions in your activity pack, answer the following question and explain how you got your answer.

On Monday, New World has three boxes of toilet rolls. Countdown has four boxes of the same toilet rolls, with enough for one roll each for 24 people altogether. How many people could have one roll each from New World?

By Tuesday, one third of the toilet rolls at Countdown have sold, and half of the toilet rolls from New World have sold.

If 18 more people want toilet rolls, is there enough for them at the two supermarkets?



If the weather is fine go outside and explore. Can you find an insect / spider / centipede?



Look closely, what do you see?

Draw and label what you find.
