Hi Room 7, it was wonderful to see your posts on Daffodil Day. Here is your next learning plan. I hope you are feeling happy and getting outside to play between the spring showers. Remember there are also lots of kids activities and story books online if you can access it. Take lots of photos and send them to my email so we can show them to the rest of the class when school opens. Read your practice readers from your school pack. Now choose one of your Duffy books or a story online and read this together with an adult. Discuss the story and your favourite parts. You could act out some pages like we do at school and use your characters special voice, this is always fun. Remember the “ talking marks are what you will be looking out for “ . I want you to notice and name the letters you know and any small words you have learnt. Your story may have some rhyming words for you to practice saying. It may have some “ cool “ words like Pete the Cat talks about.



Today I want you to play Roll and Move with anyone in your whanau who wants join you. Just roll your dice. If it lands on a 1 clap your hands once, 2 stand up and sit down twice, 3 do 3 side-ways rolls, 4 do 4 star jumps, 5 hop 5 times one one foot, 6 do 6 bunny jumps . Now you are all warmed up I want you to get your coloured pencils and paper and Make A Monster! To do this you have to roll your dice and whatever number it lands on you have to draw that many. First start with your head, then eyes, then noses, then arms, then legs. Be creative with the colours you use. Add a mouth or horns at the end.



I want you to make a “ Food Picture “ It could be a face on top of a slice of bread, or the bread cut into shapes. You could cut up fruit, but get an adult to help with the knife. Cut oranges would make cool wheels, bananas, kiwifruit and eggs make cool eyes when they are cut. You can mash, grate or spread. Think of all the foods you could use that you have at your house, discuss it with an adult, make a plan then get creating! Take a photo and send to me so we can share them when we are back at school.

Keep getting an adult to write your new letter and number in your handwriting book for your to practice. I also want you to do some cutting and matching with letters from a magazine or a paper. I want your adult to write all the letters of the alphabet in order with their felt marker down the side of a large piece of paper or cardboard. Write the uppercase and lower case e.g Aa . You have to hunt through your magazine or paper and cut out the matching letter and glue beside. You can take as long as you like to complete this.



Here is a fun game using Clothes Pegs! Play it with all your whanau. Peg an equal amount of pegs on each others clothes, on your back. Mark out a boundary that you can run in. Someone says GO , you have to run around trying to pull the pegs off other peoples backs and peg them on to the front of your clothes. The winner is the one with the most pegs when someone says STOP. You can't touch the players in any other way.
