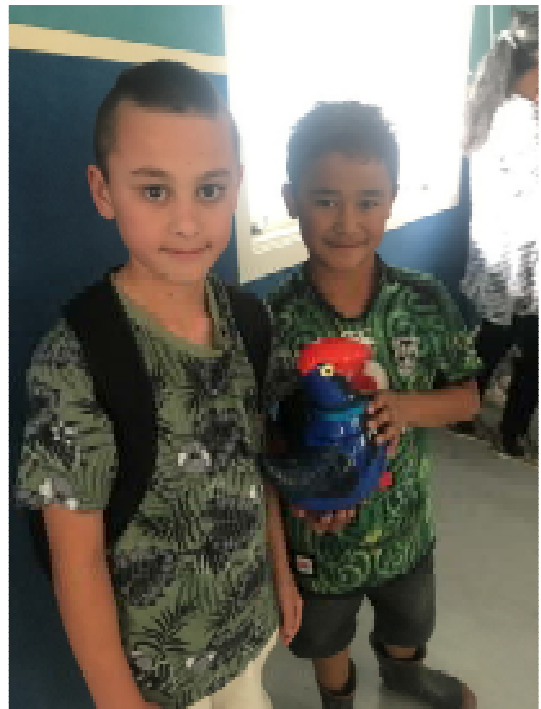
All indications are that once the country reaches its vaccination level goal then we will all be rewarded by the country 'opening up' again and, as always, it is important that we all contribute to this goal.
