Choose a number sequence that you feel happy with e.g. numbers to 20, 50, 100. Practise saying these number patterns, forward and back.

Ask someone in your bubble to play **Guess my number**. One person thinks of a number and the other person asks questions, "is your number bigger than 6"?

"Is your number smaller than 25"? "Does your number have a 7"? You can try using an interactive number board at <https://toytheater.com/hundreds-chart/> if you want.

Maybe you could count in 2's or 5's or even 10's.
