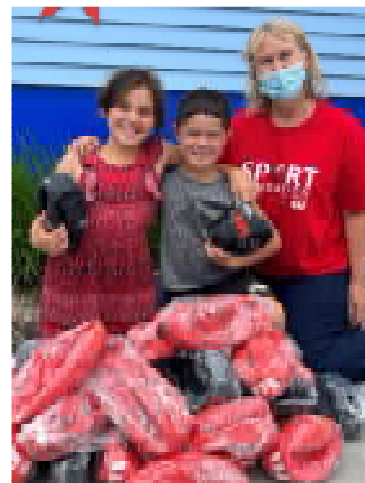
### Welcome
