

News From Room 6

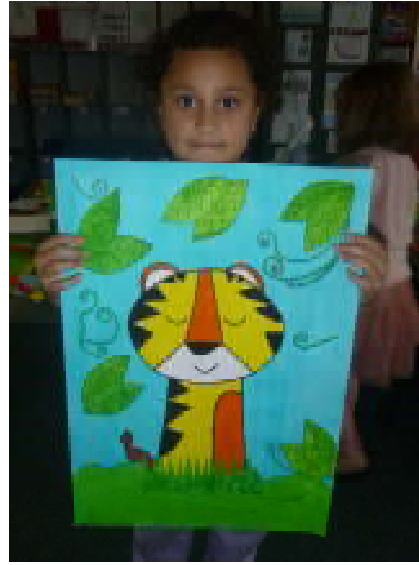

Room 6 have been busy preparing for the Art Exhibition this term. We have learnt that Artists have to put a lot of thought and effort into their work before they complete their masterpieces. We would like to share with you the stages that we used when making our cool Tiger Pictures.



First we drew our tigers following step by step guidelines on You Tube.

Next we painted our tigers with tiger colours. We also painted a background for our pictures and added a green bush in the foreground. We cut our tigers out and glued them onto the background.



We then painted some paper, green, for the leaves. We used templates to draw around and cut the leaves out before arranging them on our picture. After that we did some line drawing and drew some jungle vines to add more detail to our background and to fill any empty space.

We painted some repeating pattern strips and cut these to use for the border of our pictures.

Finally we chose some special gems to represent the berries in the bush and to add a sparkle to the vines.

We are very proud of our finished Tiger paintings. The Tiger pictures are just one of the pieces of Art that we have been working on. We are very excited and can't wait to go to the Art Exhibition when we will be able to share our work with you and others in the community.
