<p>Achieving equitable out comes for Maori students.</p>	<p>Reporting to the Board includes progress of tamariki Maori in all key curriculum areas and all children are provided additional support as required.</p> <p>Additional barriers for Tamariki Maori are identified and work undertaken to help overcome these.</p>
